The goal of the Cape Girardeau Public School's Pre-Kindergarten Program is to provide students of the Cape Girardeau Public School District with a quality pre-kindergarten opportunity. For the 2017-2018 school year, Pre-Kindergarten will be offered at Blanchard, Clippard, Franklin and Jefferson elementary schools. The morning classes will meet from 8:00 AM until 11:15 AM and the afternoon classes will meet from 12:00 PM until 3:15 PM. Pre-Kindergarten will follow the district calendar for attendance days. If there is an inclement weather day, Pre-Kindergarten will not be open.

The morning class will eat breakfast and the afternoon class will eat lunch. Breakfast is free and there is a minimal charge for lunch. Students will need to have money placed in their meal accounts, and parents may apply for free or reduced meals.
